TEACHER GUIDE (Grade 4) -

GOALS:

Students will:

- Explore a Manitoba sheep farm to discover where their food comes from
- Create food chains and food webs
- Define and use these terms:

food chain	producer	prey	herbivore	omnivore
food web	consumer	predator	carnivore	scavenger

• Identify that Canadian farmers manage food chains to produce enough good quality, safe food for the world's people to eat

CURRICULUM CONNECTIONS

 - o What food and other products do we get from sheep?

- Have students watch for:
 - o What the farmer feeds his sheep
 - o Any interesting facts about the food sheep eat
 - o The type of food people get from sheep
 - o Other products we get from sheep

- Students can add any additional answers for the two Activate questions posed above

 - *Student Activity details on p.3


Assess
