### HOW TO MAKE YOUR FORTUNE TELLER

1. Colour in the pictures and each of the triangles. Then cut outside the dotted lines.
2. Start with your square facing down. Fold on both diagonal black lines and open the paper.
3. Fold all 4 corners towards the centre so the points meet in the middle.
4. Flip it over so the folded side faces down. Again, fold all 4 corners so the points meet in the middle.
5. Fold the square in half so the 4 main pictures are facing out, unfold, then fold it in half the other way. Now slide your fingers and thumbs under the squares and push the 4 corners into the centre.



**Now you're ready to play!** With a partner, spell out one of the four categories and move your fingers back and forth. Get your partner to pick an inside category and spell it out. Pick a final category and open the flap to ask your partner the question!
