Explore food loss and waste with a hands-on kit that maps food's journey from farm to table.

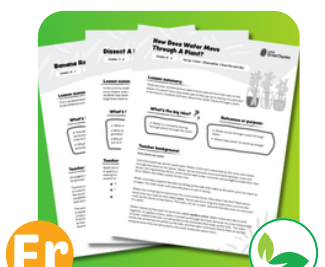
